Description

Bacteriophage T7 RNA Polymerase is a DNA-dependent RNA polymerase with high specificity for the T7 promoter. This enzyme catalyzes the 5'→3' synthesis of RNA from DNA downstream from its promoter.

T7 RNA Polymerase is supplied in 100 mM Tris-HCl (pH 7.9), 20 mM KCl, 1 mM DTT, 1 mM EDTA, 0.1% Triton® X-100 and 50% (v/v) glycerol.

Purity

>98% as determined by SDS-PAGE analysis.

Unit Definition

One unit is defined as the amount of the enzyme incorporates 1 nmol of ATP into acid-insoluble product in 1 hour at 37°C.

Reaction Condition

1× RNA Polymerase Reaction Buffer,
supplemented with 0.5 mM each ATP, UTP, GTP,
CTP, and DNA template containing the T7 RNA
Polymerase promoter. Incubate at 37°C.

10× RNA Polymerase Reaction Buffer: 400 mM
Tris-HCl (pH 8.0), 60 mM MgCl₂, and 20 mM
spermidine.

Instruction

Shipping

The product is shipped with polar packs. Upon
receipt, store it immediately at -20°C or lower
for long term storage.

Stability & Storage

This product is stable after storage at:

- -20°C or -80°C for 12 months under sterile
conditions from date of receipt.
 - For optimal storage, aliquot the enzyme,
reaction buffer and DTT reagent into smaller
quantities and store at recommended
temperature.
 - For most favorable performance, avoid
repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw
cycles.
