SIRP α is a negative regulator of immune cell activation, interacting with the "don't eat me" signal CD47 on tumor cells. It is being explored in cancer therapy to enhance anti-tumor immunity.

Instruction

Reconstitution

It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized protein in sterile H_2O to a concentration of 200 $\mu g/mL$ and incubate the stock solution for at least 20 min to ensure sufficient re-dissolved.

Stability & Storage

This product is stable after storage at:


- -20°C for 12 months in lyophilized state from date of receipt.
- -20°C or -80°C for 1 month under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.


Shipping

The product is shipped with polar packs. Upon receipt, store it immediately at -20°C or lower for long term storage.
